Not only developing Japanese language proficiency and communicative competence to the level of sufficiency to pass the entrance exam of higher education in Japan, but also a comprehension of Japanese society deepened enough to appreciate the general background of higher education through multi-cultural comprehension subject.

Preparatory Education course approved by the MEXT

To apply to a Japanese higher educational institute such as a university, junior college or a technical school, the student will need a 12 year high school education diploma. If the applicant has a diploma from a 10 year or 11 year secondary education system (countries and area such as Malaysia, Singapore, the Philippines and certain parts of China, etc.) and if they study at our school for longer than a year, they will receive a Graduation Certificate authorized by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology and will be qualified as an applicant for Japanese higher Education. For this Graduation Certificate, English class is mandatory and the student must graduate in March. Otherwise the student will receive only a completion certificate.

Practical Japanese Language Course

This course offers Japanese classes which are useful for daily I ife and business. Students will acquire the practical skills of "listening." speaking" "Reading • Writing" that transfer into social life in Japan, through learning grammar accurately ranged 10 levels from introduction to high-advanced level. In the advanced classes, more than half of the classes are electives.



- ②EJU(Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students): Students with above 220 score, excluding the score of Wrinting test. ※Only for those who apply for Comprehensive Japanese Language Course.
- ③J.TEST(Test of Practical Japanese) A-C level test: Above 600 score.
- 4)The Japanese Language NAT-TEST: Above Level 2.
- ⑤ J-Cert (Certificate of Japanese as a Foreign Language): A-course Pre-Advance or Advance Level.
- ⑥JPT(Japanese Proficiency Test): Above 525 score.
- 7)TOP-J: Above Intermidiate B.

You need to submit a written oath and a certificate showing above test score.
